**CASH CREEK GENERATION SELECTS BURNS & MCDONNELL AND
KIEWIT ENERGY AS EPC SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR COAL-TO-
SNG/POWER PROJECT IN KENTUCKY**

**PLANT'S CO2 WILL BE CAPTURED AND USED FOR ENHANCED OIL
RECOVERY**

Louisville, KY-- Cash Creek Generation, LLC (CCG), a wholly-owned subsidiary of the ERORA Group, LLC, announced today that it had contracted with Burns & McDonnell, of Kansas City, MO, to perform EPC engineering design services for the Company's coal to substitute natural gas and power project planned for Henderson County, Kentucky. Contracted services will include engineering design for the coal-gasification-to-SNG plant, including all gasification process systems, refinement of the plant site plan and general arrangement, and design of balance-of-plant systems and equipment. Burns & McDonnell has contracted with Kiewit Energy Company to provide construction assistance and estimate support.

CCG has also signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Kiewit Energy Company, of Houston, TX, related to the engineering, procurement and construction services necessary to construct the Cash Creek Project. Those services will include the coal-gasification-to-SNG plant, a nominal 720 MW natural gas combined-cycle power plant, and associated balance-of-plant processes including carbon dioxide ("CO2") capture and compression equipment.

ERORA's Michael McInnis, Managing Director, said, "We are delighted to be working with Burns & McDonnell and Kiewit on the Cash Creek project, which will be one of the first operational commercial-scale clean coal plants. It will put Kentucky coal to good use in producing two valuable commodities, synthetic pipeline-quality gas, and electricity, in an environmentally-sound fashion, that includes CO2 capture for enhanced oil recovery."

"Burns & McDonnell is excited to expand its long-standing relationship with ERORA by performing engineering design for the project" said Jim Jurczak, Director, Gasification Projects, at Burns & McDonnell. "The project represents an efficient and environmentally-superior approach to using our most abundant energy resource, coal."

"We are extremely pleased to be working for ERORA on this clean coal power and SNG facility," said Dan Lumma, Vice President of Kiewit Energy's Gasification Business. "It is an exciting project that will bring good jobs to Kentucky and produce clean, home-grown energy".

Plans for the Cash Creek Project include a gasification facility converting coal into SNG, to be sent to natural gas pipelines, with a combined-cycle power plant to generate electricity.

The plant is expected to employ approximately 250 operations people once it is completed in 2012. The construction labor force is expected to exceed 1,500 at peak. Coal required for the plant is expected to result in the creation of 150 new mining jobs with annual coal consumption of approximately three million tons.

The process plant separates a highly concentrated CO₂ gas stream from the synthesis gas. This CO₂ stream will be compressed and injected into a pipeline for use in enhanced oil recovery.
